Abstract

The abstract should summarize the contents of the paper. It should be set in 10 point Times, italic, justified and inset 1.0 cm from right and left margins.

***Keywords:** You can list your keywords in this section.*

1 Introduction

All submitted papers must follow the guidelines given in this document. Papers that do not comply with these guidelines will not be considered for publishing.

This document can be used as a template. The sections can be formatted applying the defined styles. Please send the final and checked Word document to editor in-chief.

2 Paper Format

The paper size must be custom size with 17 cm width and 24 cm height. The margins are 2.5 cm at top, 2 cm at bottom, 2 cm at inside and outside. All printed material must be inside the print area. All text must be in a one column format and text must be fully justified.

2.1 Main Title

The main title of the paper should be at the top edge of the first page, centered and in Times 16 point boldface type. The first letter of words except articles, prepositions and conjunctions should be capitalized.

2.2 Author names and affiliations

Author names, affiliations and e-mails are to be centered beneath the main title and written in Times 12 point, non-boldface type.

2.3 Headings

2.3.1 First-Order Heading

The first-order headings should be 16 point Times, bold, and 18 point spacing before and 6 point spacing after.

2.3.2 Second-Order Headings

They should be Times 14 point, boldface, left aligned, and 12 point spacing before and 6 point spacing after.

2.3.3 Third-Order Headings

For third-order headings, use 12 point Times, boldface, left aligned, and 6 point spacing before and 6 point spacing after.

2.4 Main Text

Type your main text in 12 point Times, single-spaced. The paragraphs use 6 points spacing after and they should be justified.

Paragraphs can contain bullets or numbers. Bold and italic fonts can be used to emphasize words, phrases or sentences.

2.5 Equations

Mathematical equations which are not built-in a text line, should be centered in a separate line and must be considered as a separate paragraph. The equations should be numbered for reference, with numbers enclosed in parentheses.

$$S(\vec{x}, \vec{y}) = \frac{\sum_{i=1}^n S(x_i, y_i).W_i}{\sum_{i=1}^n W_i} \quad (1)$$

2.6 Figures and Tables

All figures and tables should be numbered. Figure captions should appear below each figure, whereas table captions should appear on top of each table and they both have 6 point spacing before and after.

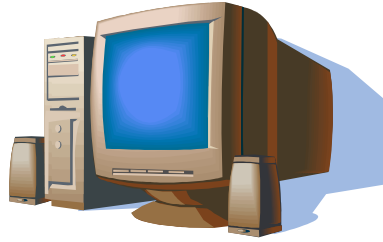


Figure 1. Description Text

Figure and table captions should be 11 point Times italic and centered. Figures and tables must be numbered separately.

2.7 Program Codes

Program codes should be in courier.

2.8 Footnotes

The superscript numbers should be used to refer to a footnote just after the related word to be explained like¹.

3 References

Please use square brackets and consecutive numbers for citations in the paper like [1], [2], etc.

At the end of the paper, all references should be presented in alphabetical order, using the format below.
